


No variations in the height of surround caps is accepted.


> Concrete deck thickness minimum 10 cm (350 kg concrete)

For a cover with a standard 35 cm overlap, the deck must extend at least 80 cm around the full circumference of the pool when using the double-ended bungee cords, and at least 95 cm for the continuous bungee cord. Alternatively, there must be at least 10 cm available after the anchor points.

## INSTALLING THE COVER


The cover must have a standard and regular <u>35 cm</u> overlap (approx.) around the full circumference of the pool.







TRACING THE ANCHOR LINE AND ANGLES






## **CLOSING UP THE POOL**

## **OPENING UP THE POOL**




Unhook all the anchorages. Slide the cover onto the deck.

Clean and dry the anchorages.

Clean and dry the cover before folding and storing in a dry place.

Pack everything away in the storage bag (OPTIONAL) and store in a dry, ventilated room away from light.



#### WINTERING

- Close the cover.
- Do not lower the water level.
- Turn off the filtration.
- Remove snow regularly.

Warning, a covering of snow of more than 20 cm on the cover may cause irreversible damage to your equipment.

Installing a **"Support cable"** is recommended.

- If conditions are windy, weigh down the edges of the cover with water bladders or sandbags.

## UPKEEP (USER'S RESPONSIBILITY)

The correct upkeep of your winter cover is the best way to guarantee a long product lifetime. Regularly clean the cover with a hose so that leaves do not accumulate and rot on top. Do not use abrasives or solvents to clean the cover.

#### MAINTENANCE

All maintenance operations must be performed by a professional, who will contact the manufacturer if necessary (details on the back of the document).

Only use original spare parts.

Regularly check the condition of the cover (bungees, eyelet pegs, anchorages, cover seams and welds ...) at the beginning and end of wintering, or following any type of accident.

Replace the defective parts if they are damaged.

In windy regions, particular attention must be paid to the cover rubbing on the surround caps.

The double-ended bungees and the continuous bungee must be changed every 3 years.
